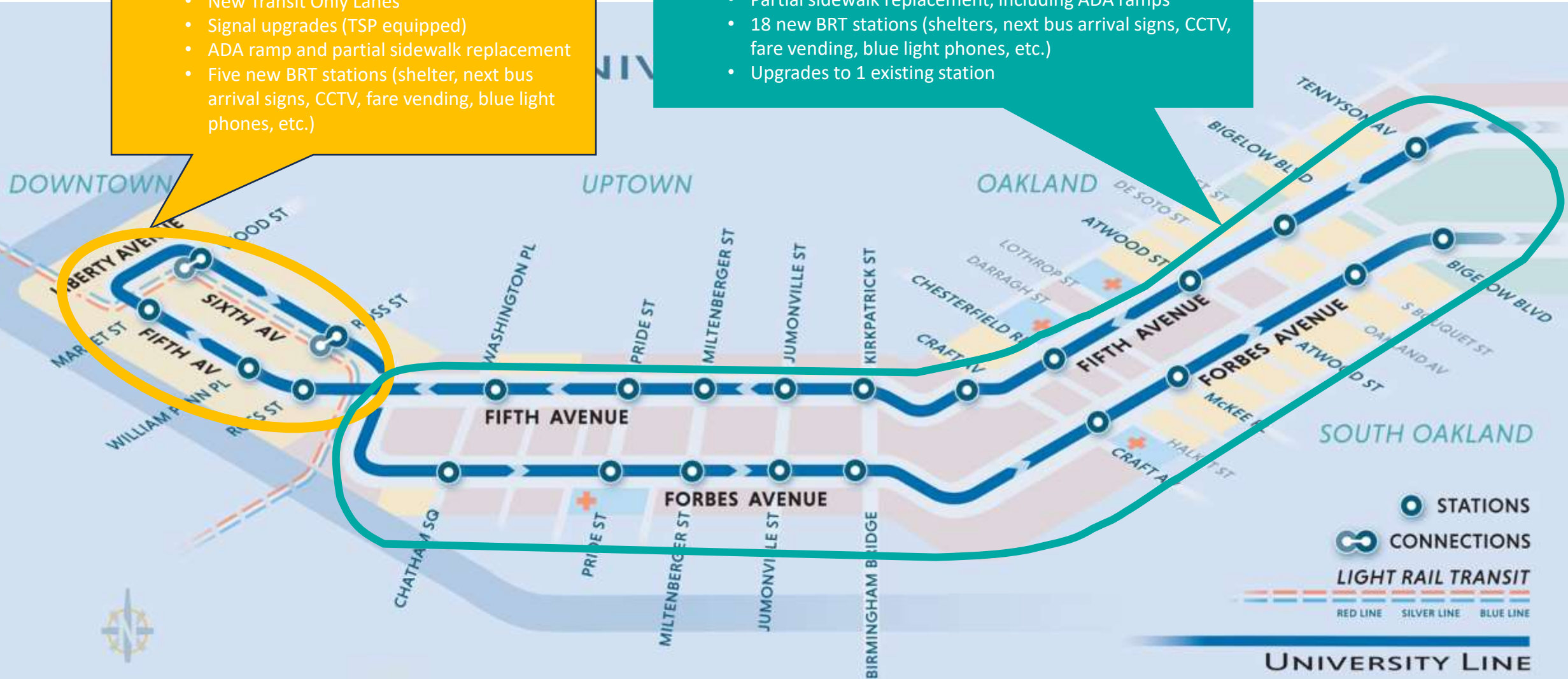
Map

1st Phase (BRT: Downtown Loop)

- New Transit Only Lanes
- Signal upgrades (TSP equipped)
- ADA ramp and partial sidewalk replacement
- Five new BRT stations (shelter, next bus arrival signs, CCTV, fare vending, blue light phones, etc.)

2nd Phase (BRT: Uptown & Oakland)

- New Transit Only Lanes
- New protected bike lanes
- Signal upgrades and replacements (TSP equipped)
- Partial sidewalk replacement, including ADA ramps
- 18 new BRT stations (shelters, next bus arrival signs, CCTV, fare vending, blue light phones, etc.)
- Upgrades to 1 existing station

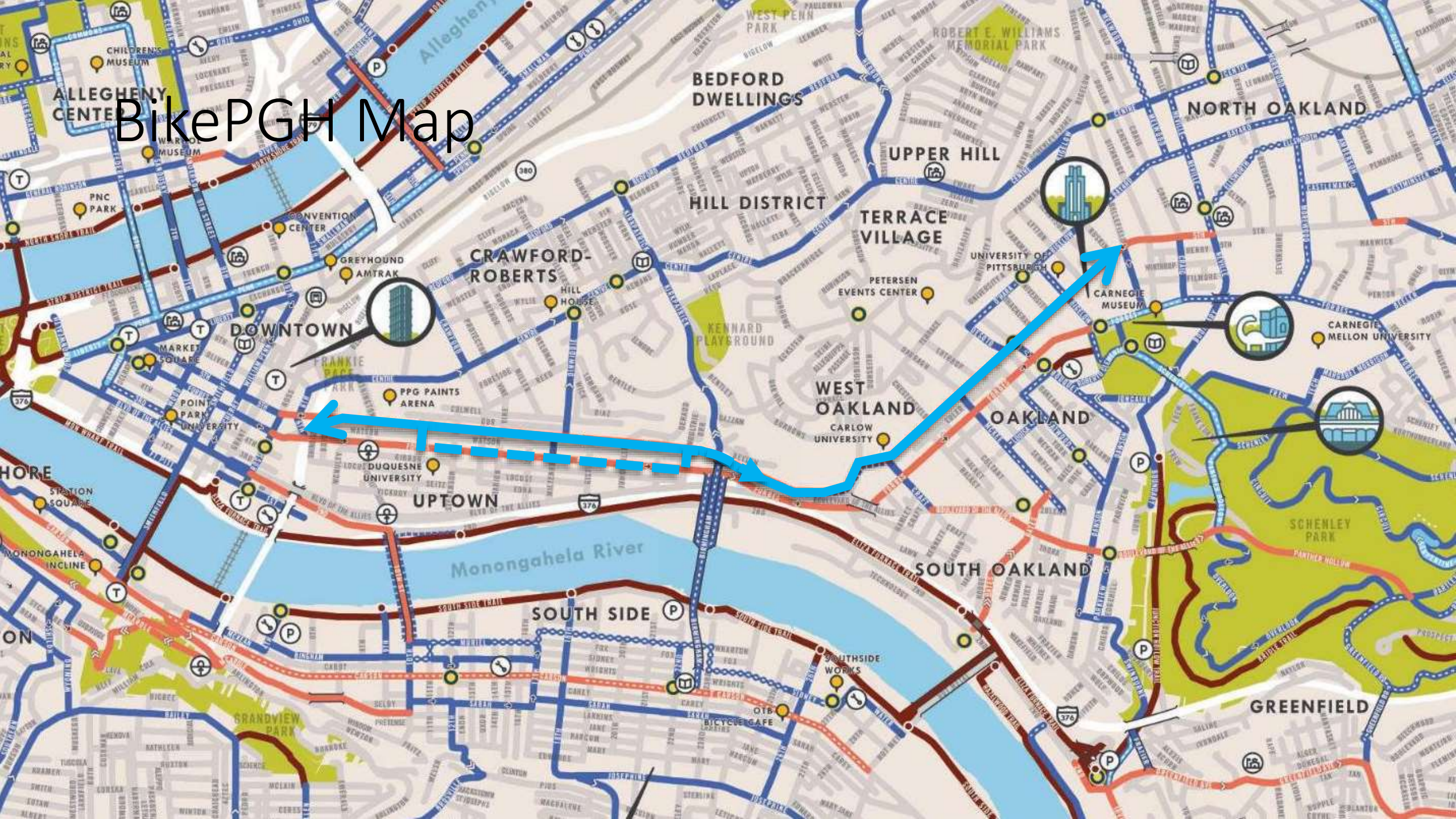

Bike+ Plan Map

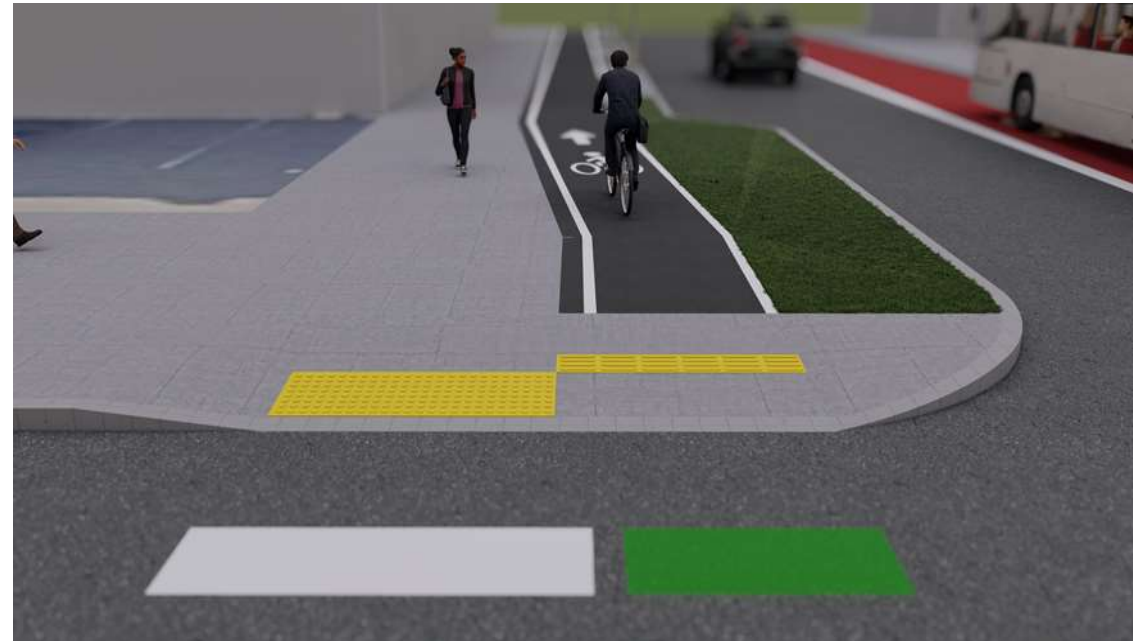

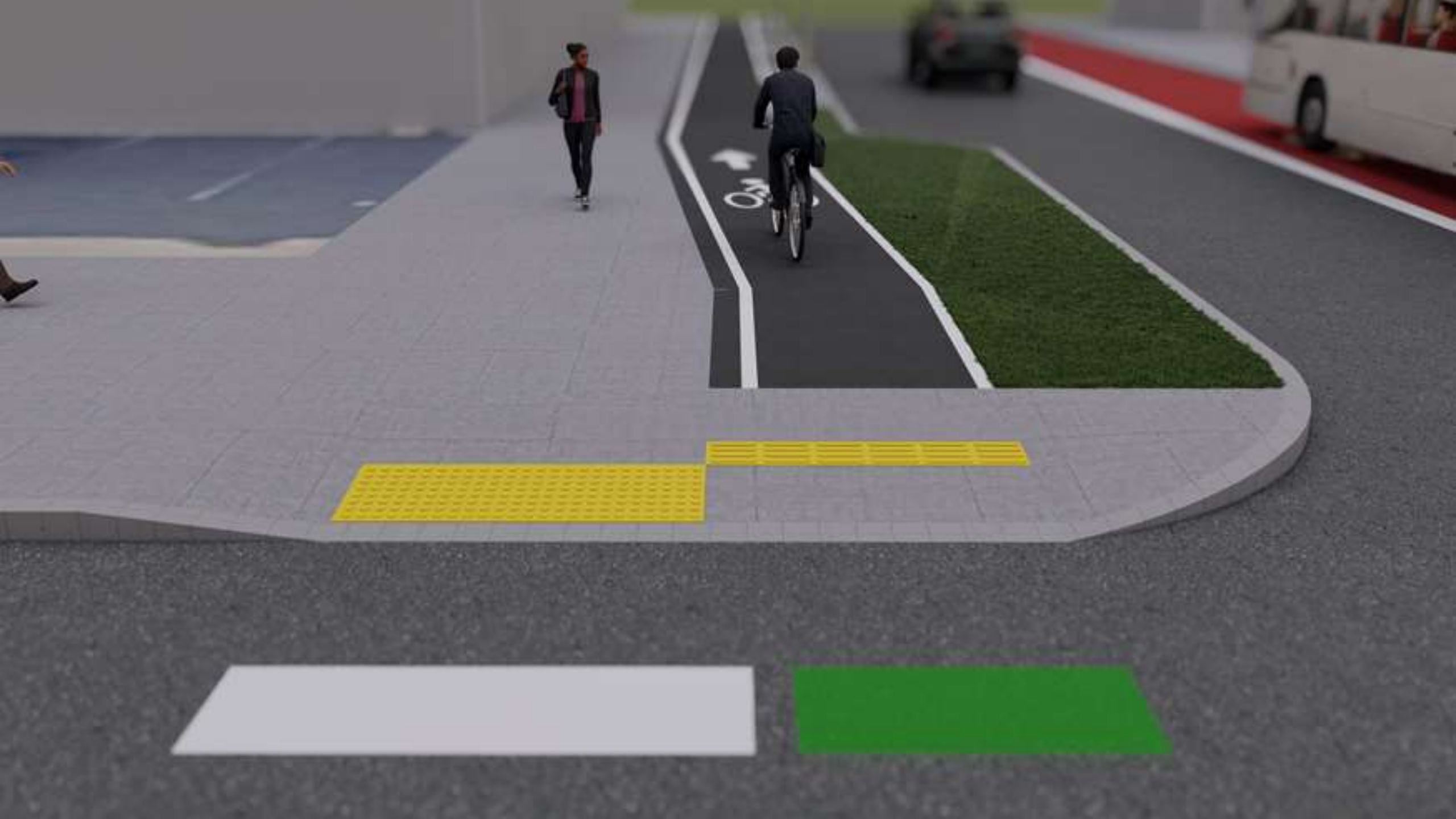

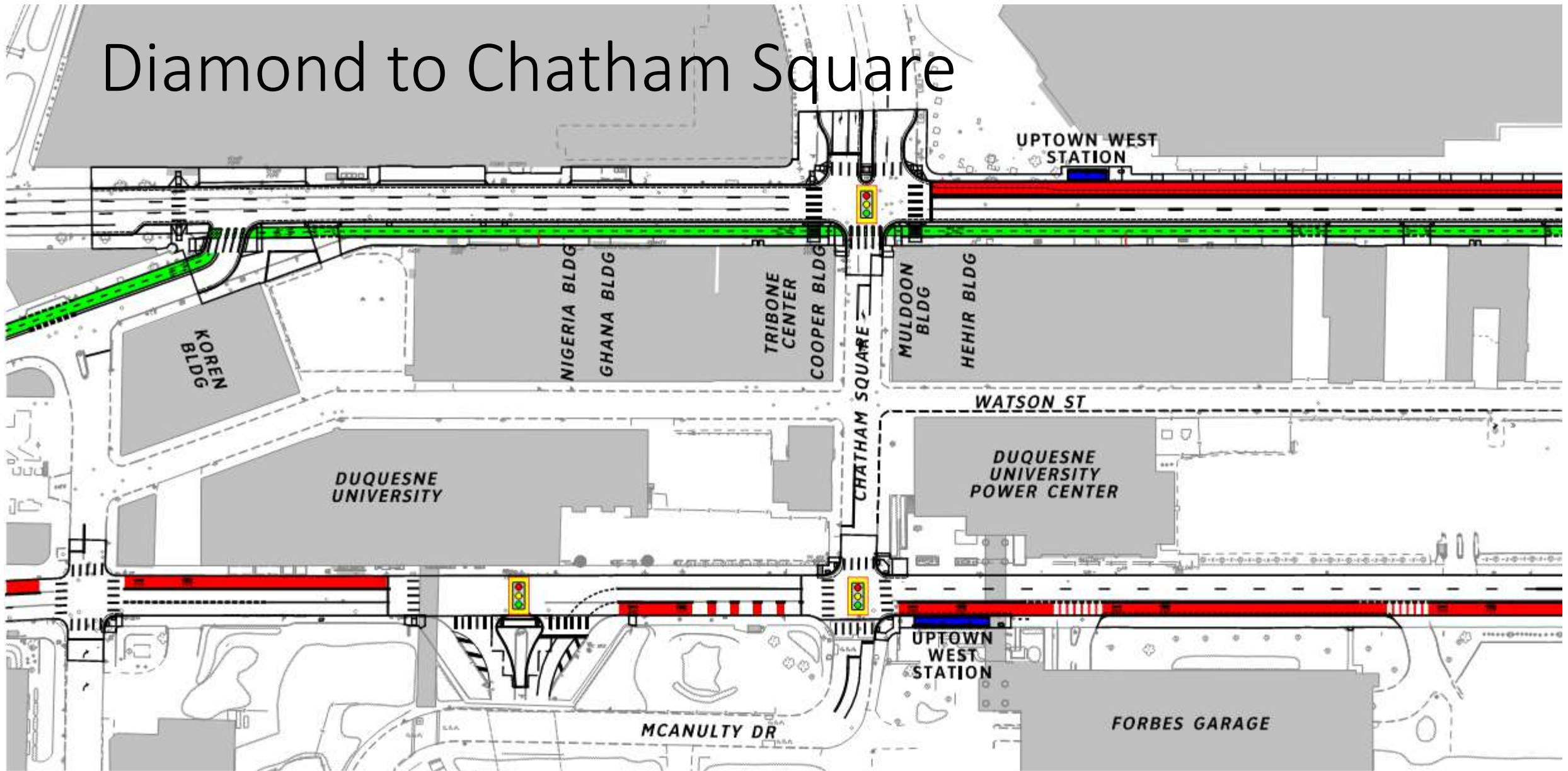
- Bike Lanes at Sidewalk Level

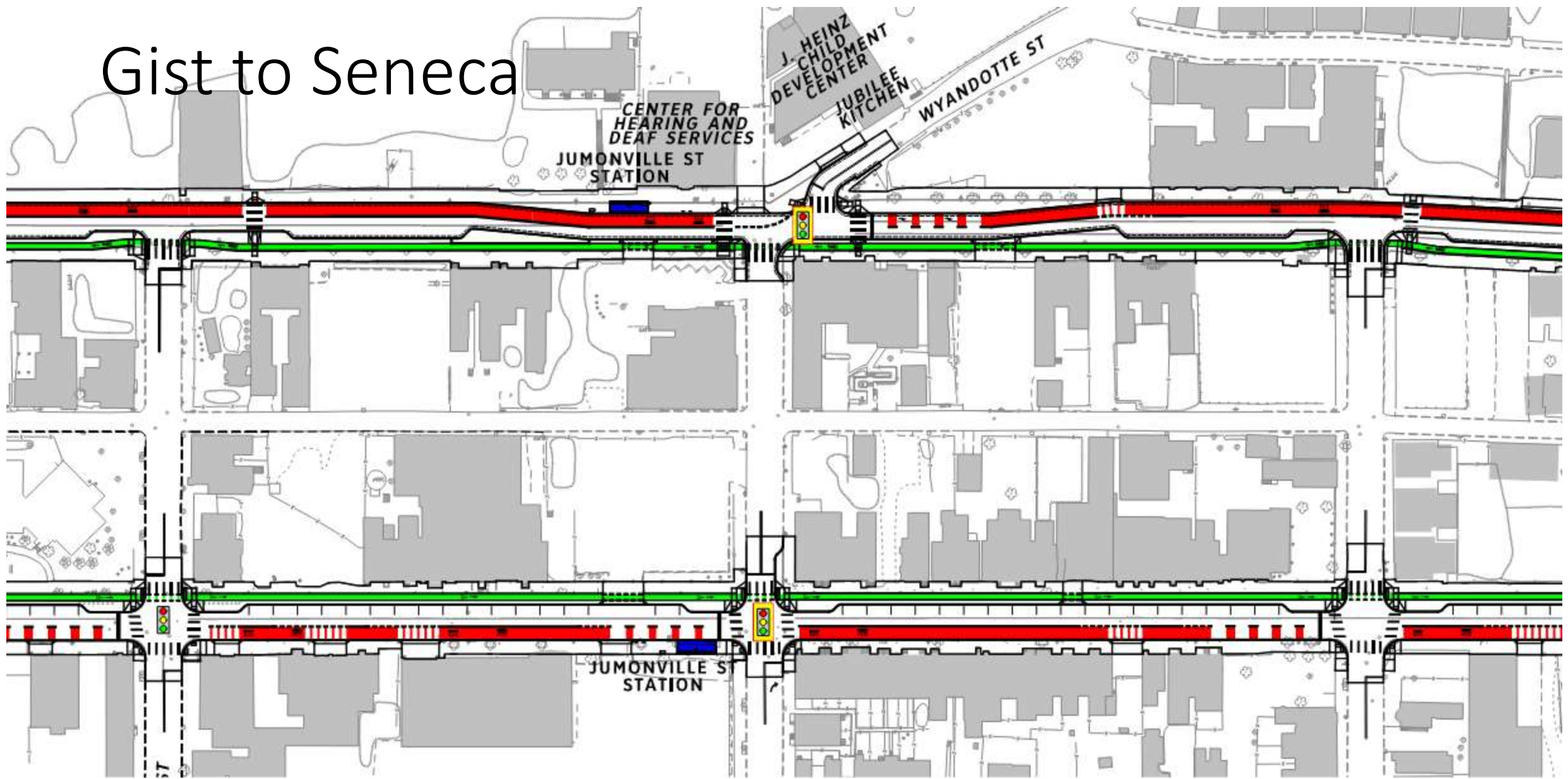

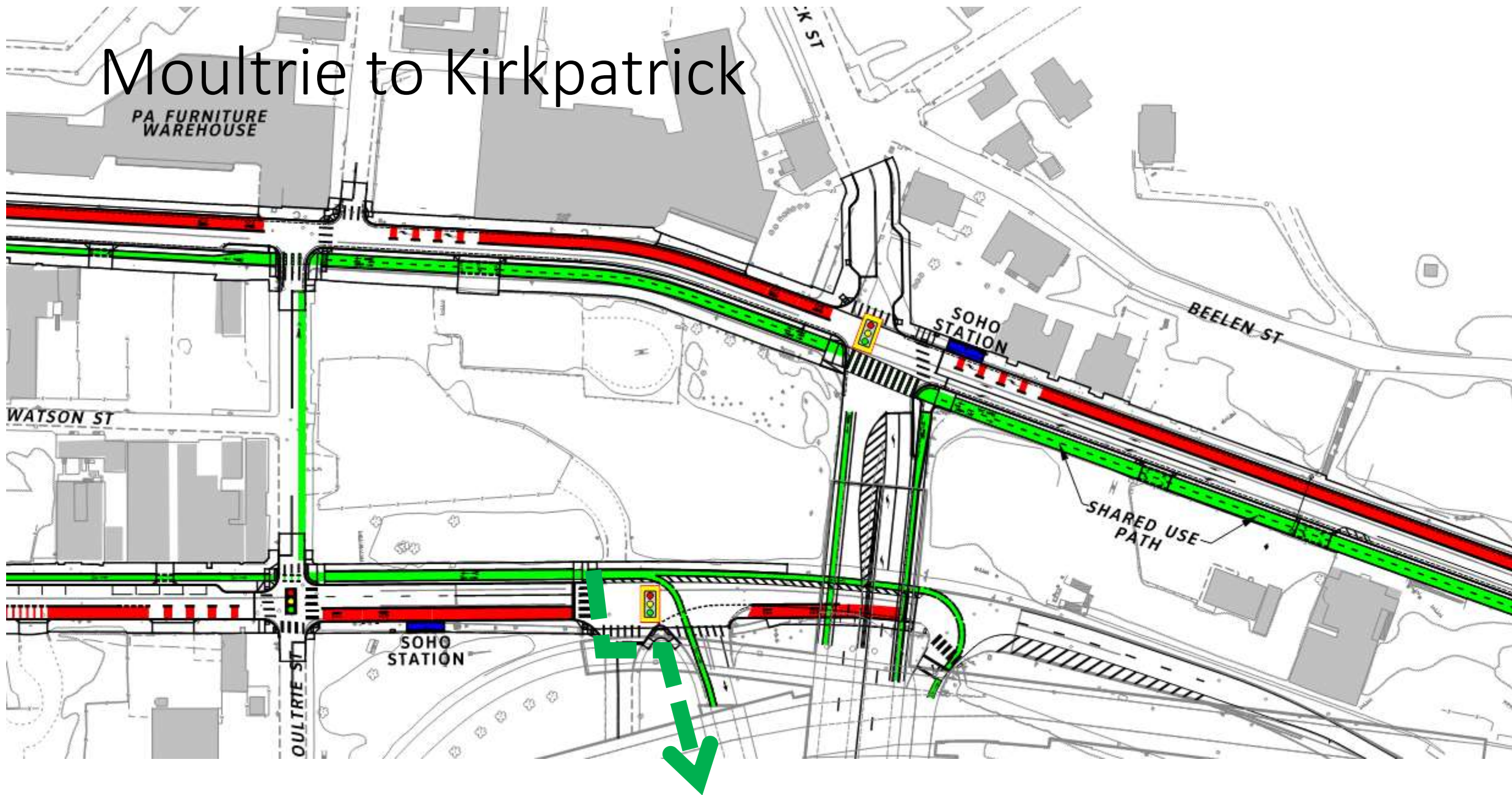

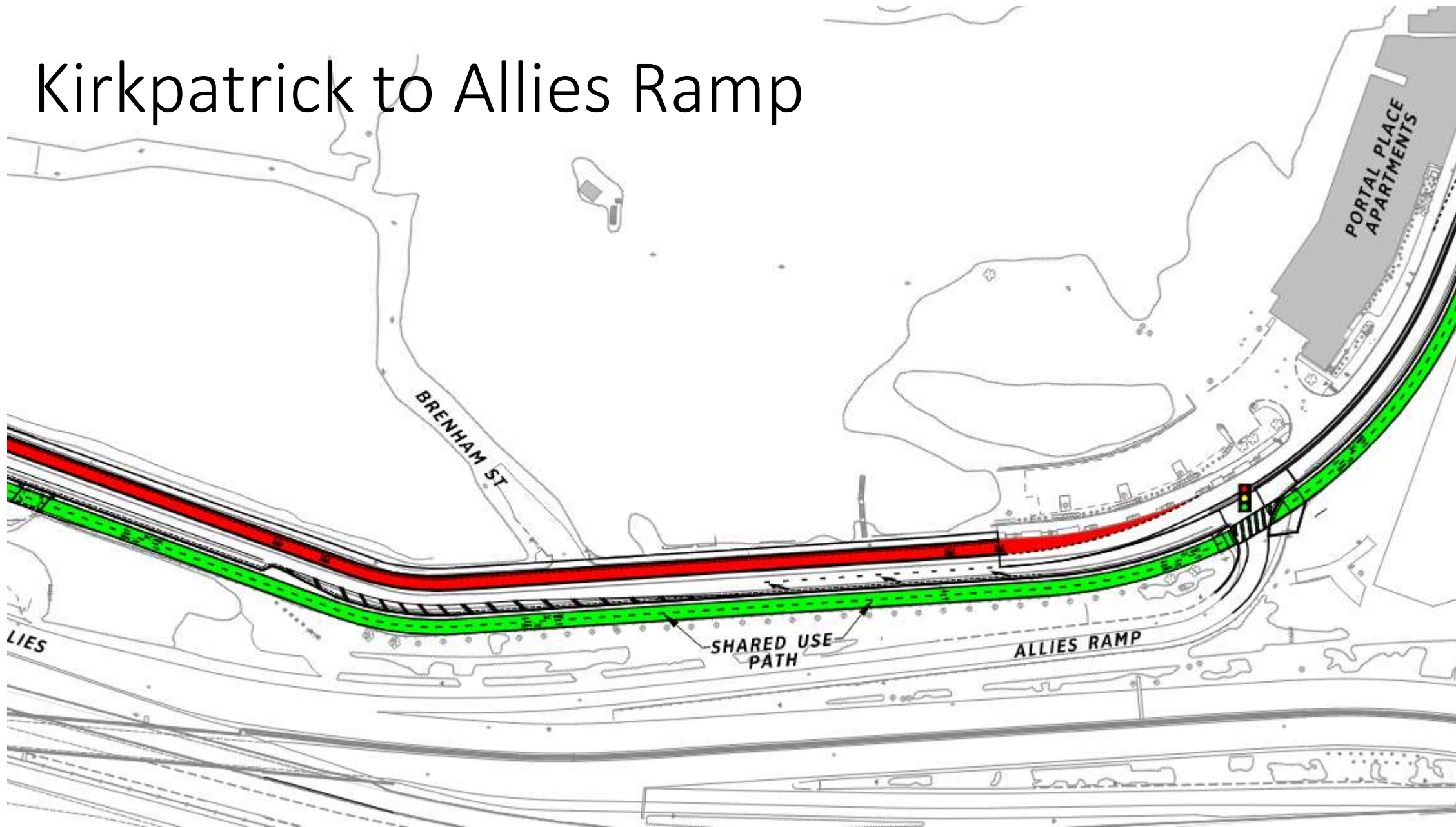

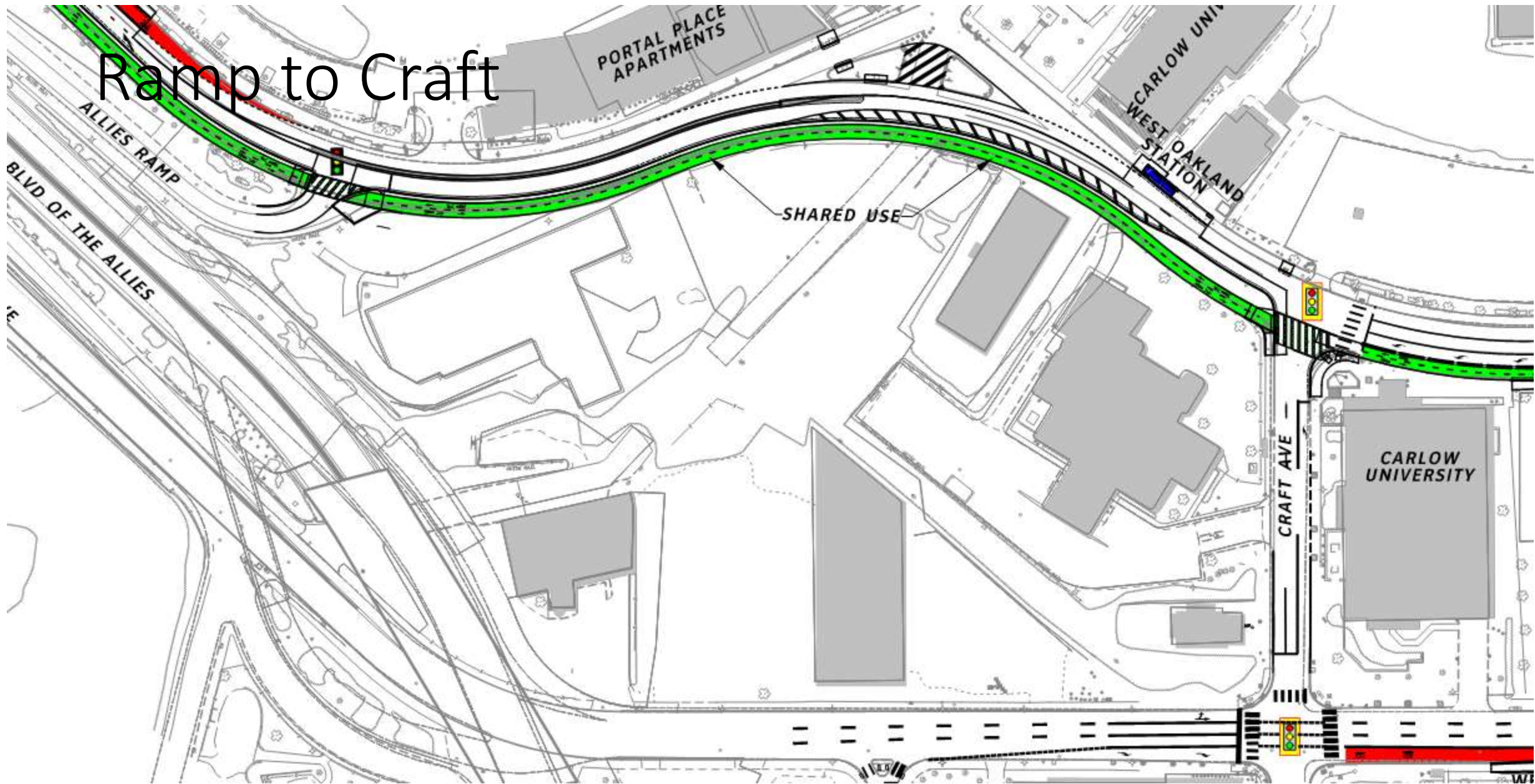

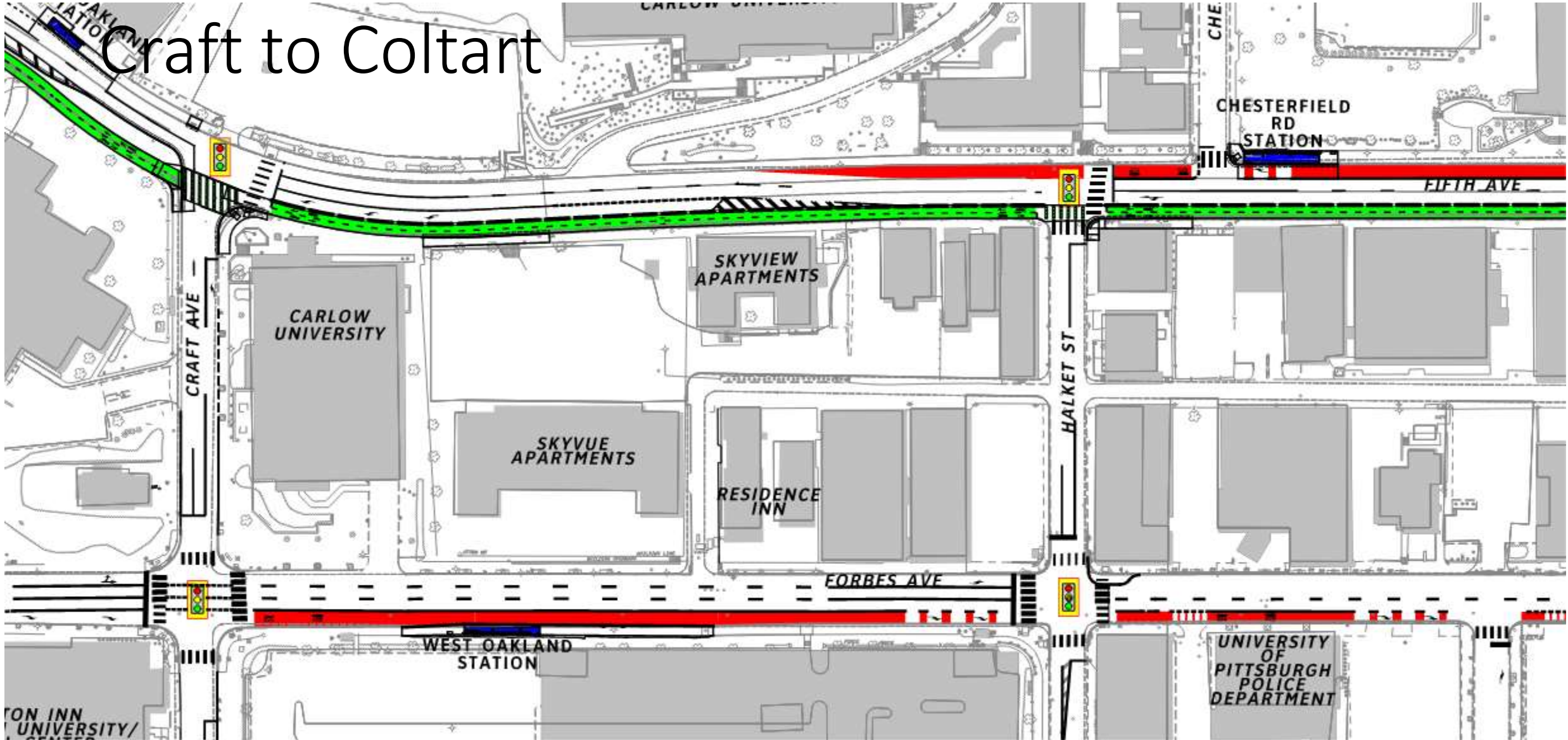
Kirkpatrick to Allies Ramp



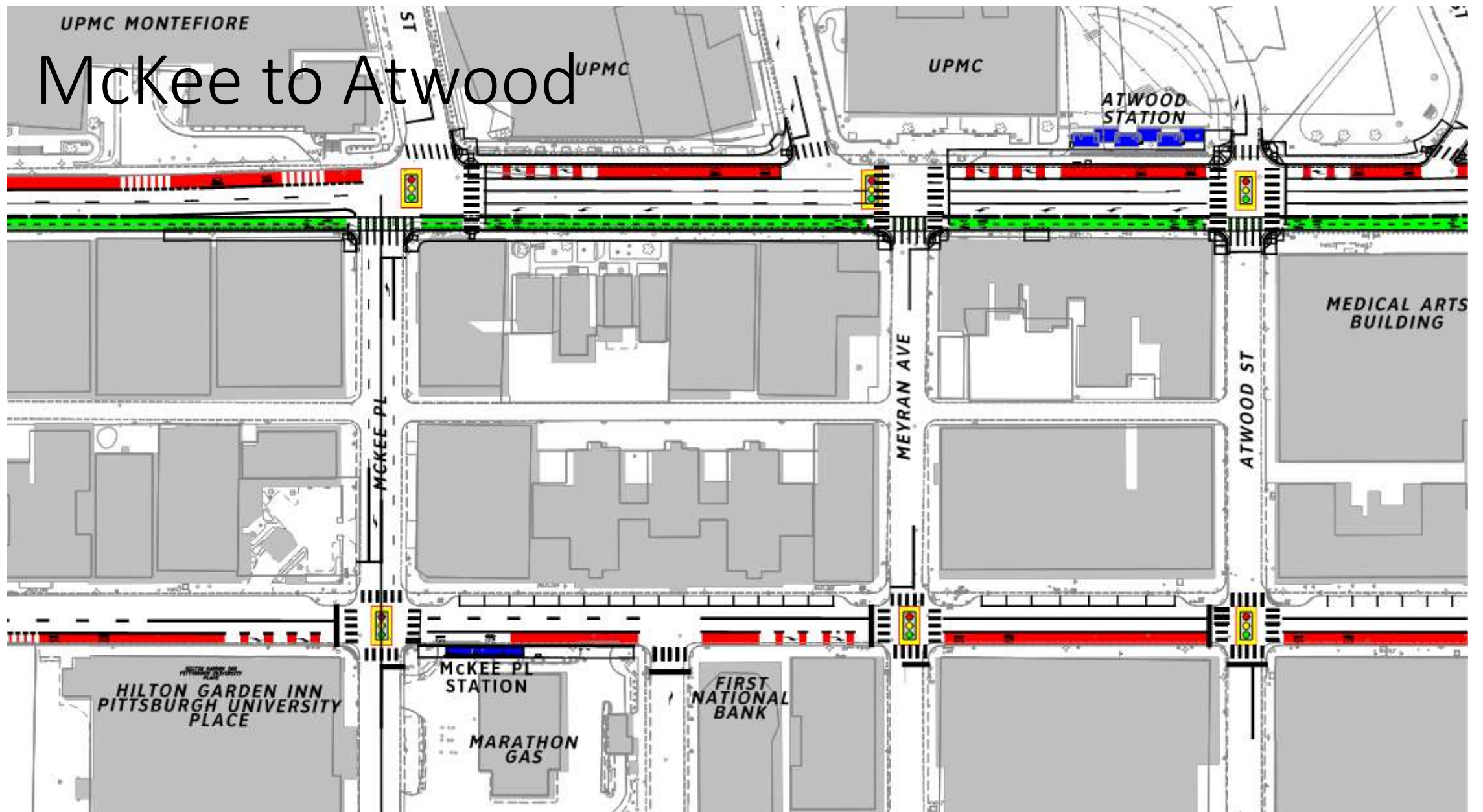

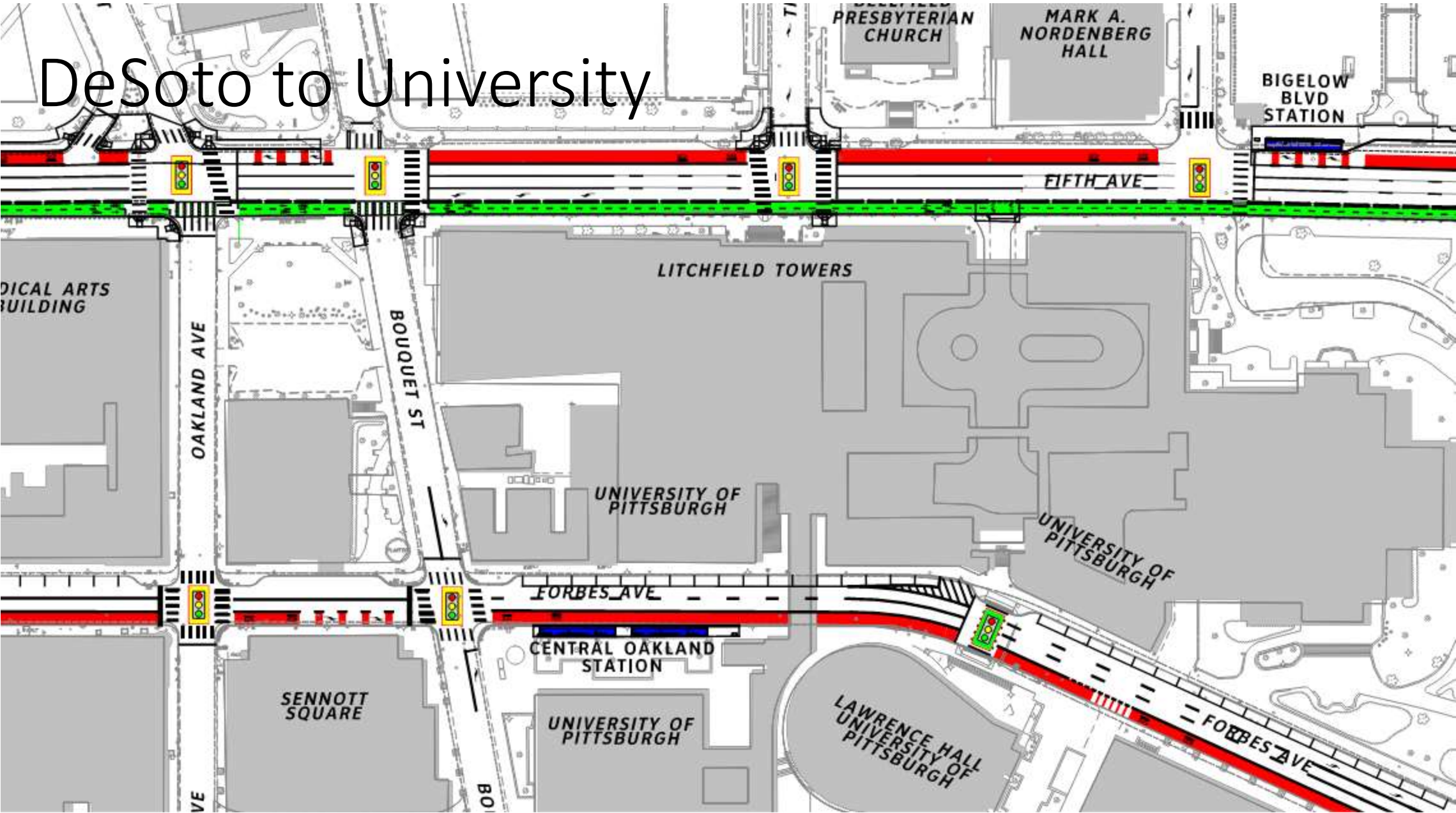

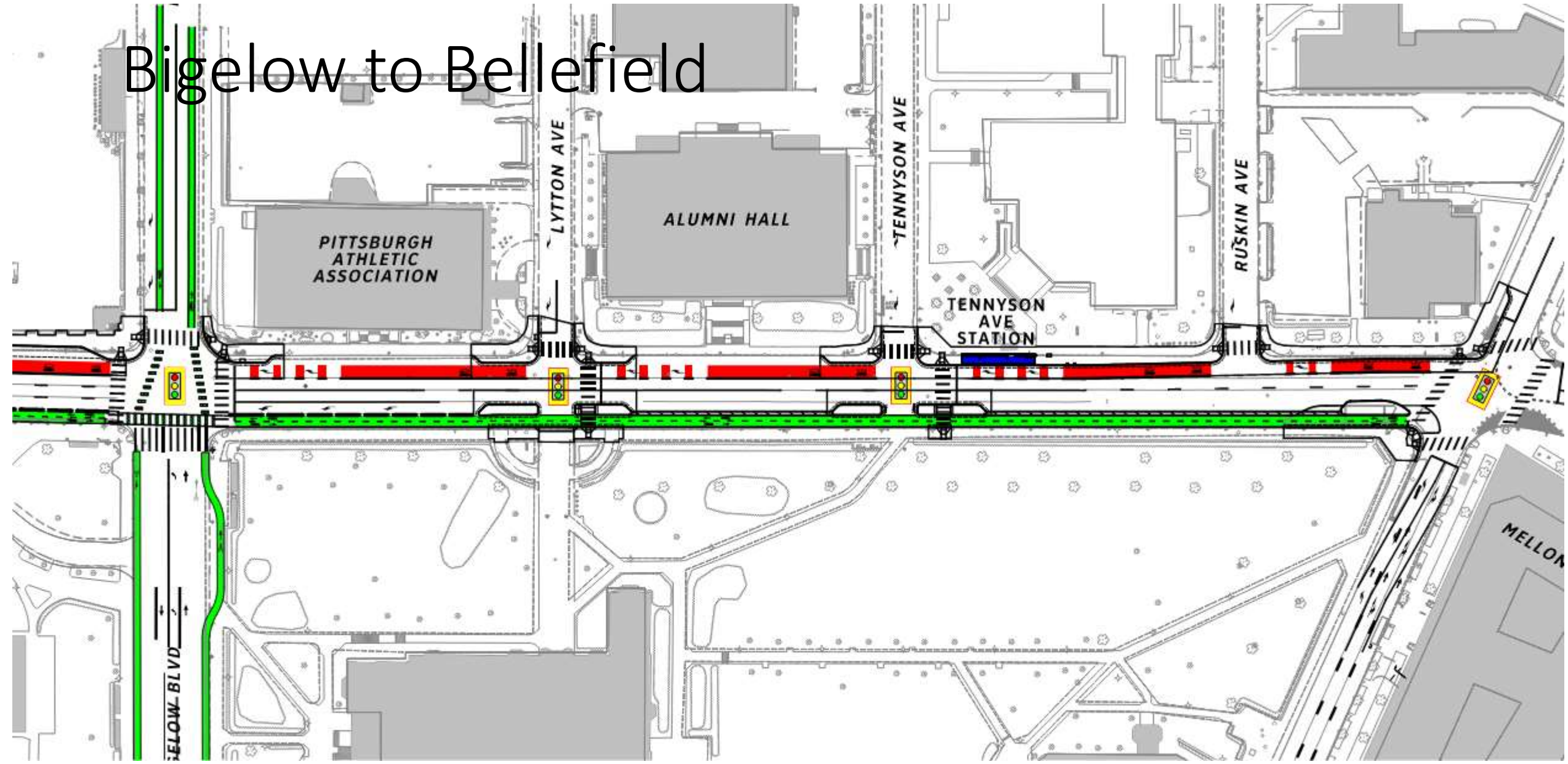

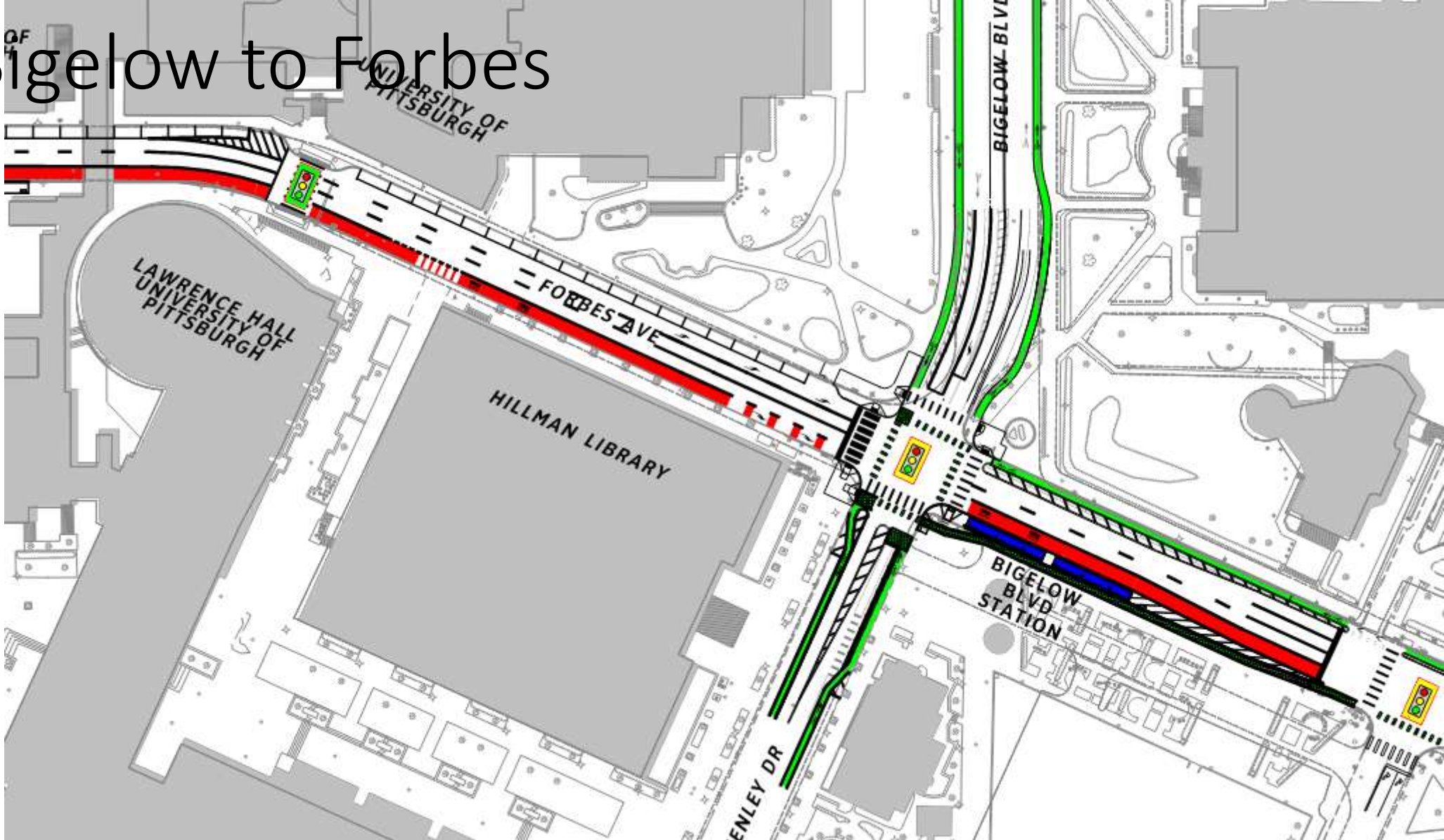

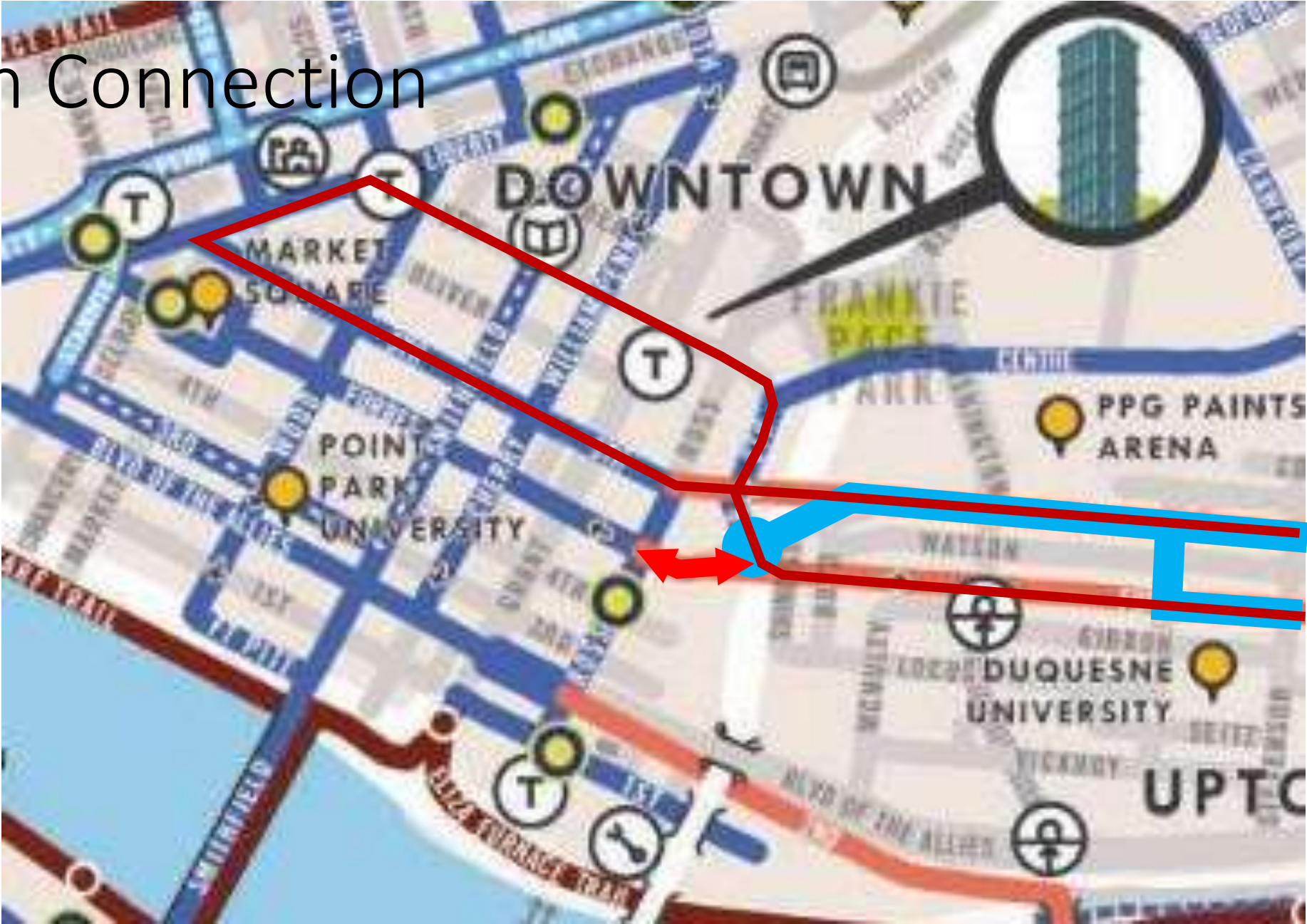

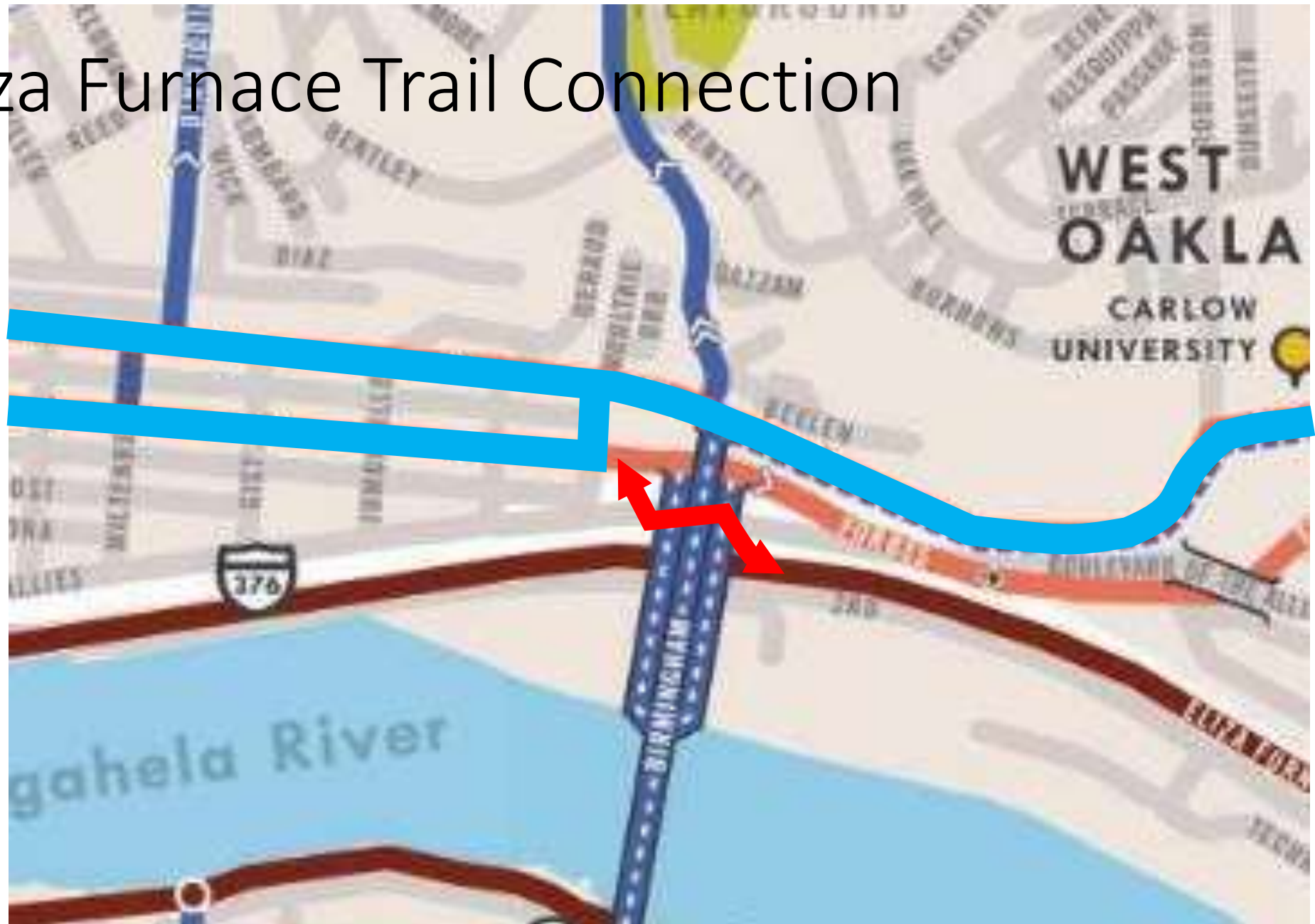

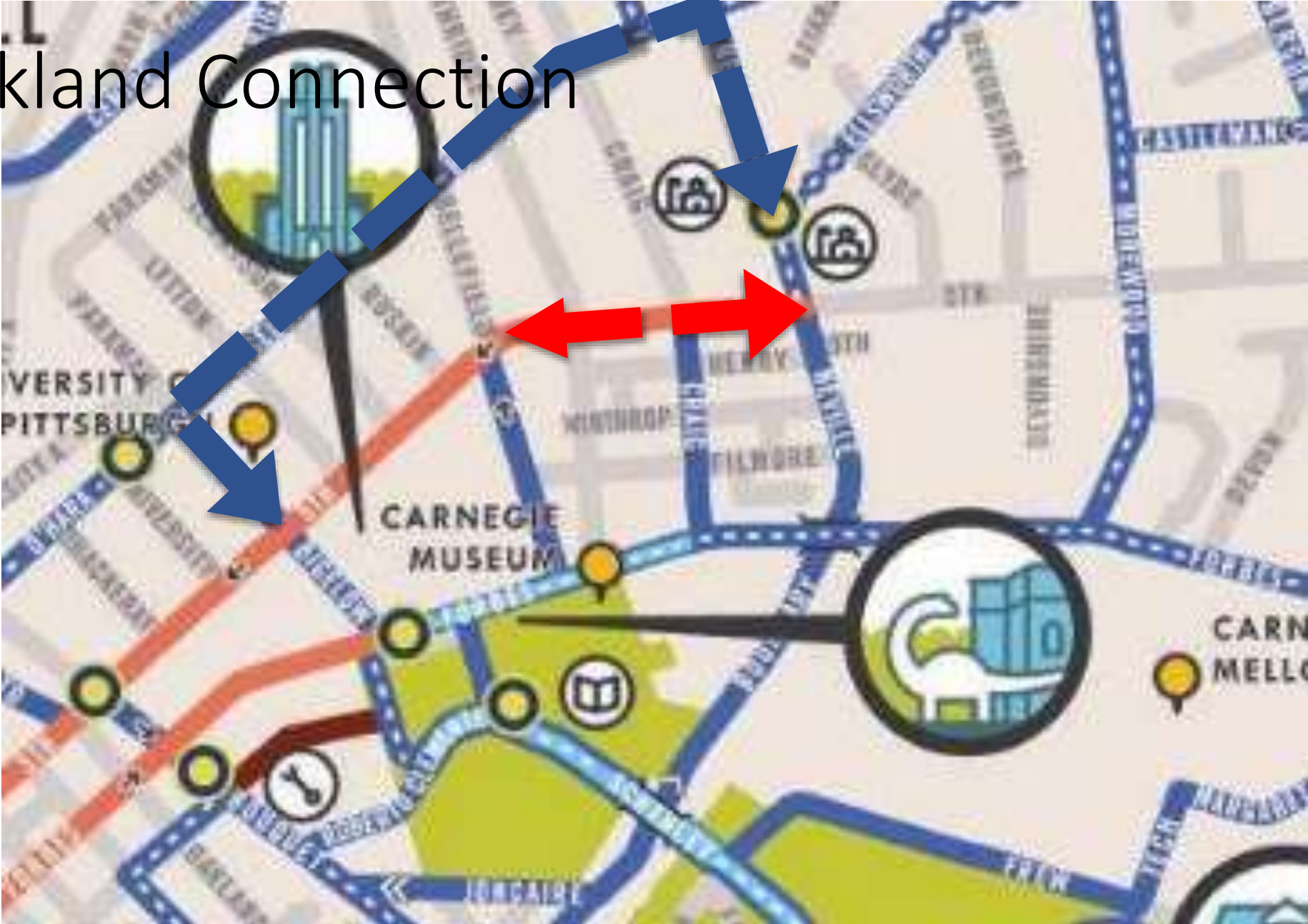
Downtown Connection
